THE TRADITION LADIES GOLF ASSOCIATION BY-LAWS

Adopted 1998

ARTICLE 1: NAME

The name of the organization shall be The Tradition Ladies' Golf Association.

ARTICLE 2: OBJECT

The Tradition Ladies' Golf Association is organized for weekly play of golf and tournaments. The object of the organization is to promote good sportsmanship while observing the rules and etiquette of golf.

ARTICLE 3: MEMBERSHIP

- A. Charter membership shall be limited to 60 Lady Members, who are at least eighteen years of age and are members of The Tradition Golf Club.
 - 1. Members are defined as those who pay their annual dues to The Tradition Golf Club.
 - 2.Residents of the Tradition that have been granted membership privileges as a condition of employment at **The Tradition Golf** Club may also become charter members of the Ladies' Golf Association.*
 - * The only exception to the residency requirement will be for those who were members of the TLGA on or before October 9, 1997.
- **B.** Members of the Ladies' Golf Association must have a U.S.G.A. 18 hole handicap to play in weekly tournaments and keep their handicaps at The Tradition Golf Club.
- C. Charter members are required to play at least 12 Association Tournaments a year.
- D. Auxiliary members shall be defined as:
 - 1. members who play less than 12 times a year.
 - 2. members who are waiting to become Charter members, once a capacity of 60 members has been reached.
- E. Auxiliary members may play as alternates when space is available and will be included in weekly prize money.
- F. Auxiliary members must pay yearly dues.

ARTICLE 4: DUES/FEES

A. The Executive Board shall determine the annual dues based on the proposed budget for the coming year. Yearly dues are to be paid by January 15th, unless there is an extenuating circumstance. Dues may be increased with a majority vote of the membership at the first meeting of the year.

B. Weekly prize money and pools may be increased with a majority vote of the membership at the first meeting of the year.

ARTICLE 5: MEETINGS

There shall be at least three meetings held each year. The last meeting of the year will be held in conjunction with the annual awards luncheon/dinner in December.

ARTICLE 6: OFFICERS

A. The President, 1st & 2nd Vice Presidents, Secretary and Treasurer shall be elected by ballot.

B. The Executive Board shall be comprised of the President, 1st & 2nd Vice Presidents, Secretary and Treasurer.

C. The 2nd Vice President shall be elected to serve on the Executive Board for three consecutive years.

- 1. First year as 2nd Vice President.
- 2. Second year as 1st Vice President.
- 3. Third Year as President.
- D. The term of each office shall be one year.

ARTICLE 7: DUTIES OF THE OFFICERS

A. PRESIDENT shall preside at all meetings and approve all activities of the Association. She shall appoint any special chairpersons or committees she deems necessary including a Myrtle Beach Invitational Chairperson.

B. 1ST VICE-PRESIDENT shall assist the President at all times in the fulfillment of her duties and shall preside at all meetings and events in the absence of the President. She will also be in charge of any and all special events: Member/Member, Member/Guest, Club Championship and the Ladies' Cup.

C. 2ND VICE-PRESIDENT shall assist the President and 1st Vice-President in the fulfillment of their duties and will preside at all meetings and events in the absence of the President and 1st Vice-President. She will also be in charge of the weekly tournaments and assist in any other tournaments.

- **D. SECRETARY** shall keep attendance, minutes of all meetings, handle any correspondence with the Association and any other duties assigned to her by the President.
- E. TREASURER shall handle all finances of the Association and keep a record of such. She shall deposit all monies in a local bank in the name of the Association. All checks should be signed by her or the president. She shall report on the financial condition of the Association at any meeting thereof. At the end of the year, she will help prepare a budget for the ensuing year and see that a minimum of \$60.00 be available for transfer to the new Treasurer.

F. VACANCY ON THE EXECUTIVE BOARD

- 1. The Executive Board may appoint a substitute to fill any vacancy in an elected office on a temporary basis.
- 2. A special election must be held within thirty days to fill the position for the unexpired term of office.

ARTICLE 8: WEEKLY PLAY

- A. Play is to be held on Thursday of each week, with a show up time 30 minutes prior to Tee Time.
- B. Eight (8) or more players are required to constitute a tournament.
- C. To be eligible to play, players must sign up 48 hours prior to Tee Time.
- **D.** Any player unable to play must notify an officer of cancellation **48** hours prior to Tee Time.
- E. The 2nd Vice President will plan weekly play and determine the prize distribution of the day.
- **F.** All adjusted game scores are to be posted immediately after play by each member. Chip-ins, Birdies and Eagles only apply on Tournament Day.
- G. Posting on Ringer Board will be handled by the Ringer Board Chairman.

ARTICLE 9: TOURNAMENTS A. Presidents Cup

Will be played using full handicap and all participants must have played 12 times in league tournaments to qualify. It will be played after the second Thursday in September and before the third Thursday in November.

B. CLUB CHAMPIONSHIP

Will be played by flights. All participants must have played 12 times in league tournaments to qualify. It will also be played after the second Thursday in September and before the third Thursday in November.

C. MEMBER-GUEST

Will be open to all members. Guests **must** have current USGA handicap and tournament will be played to full handicap.

Myrtle Beach Ladies Golf Invitational

All members of the Ladies Association are eligible to play with the following restrictions:

- 1. The Club's Invitational Representative shall have the right to play in all events, if she so chooses.
- 2. If at such a time the field is over subscribed, and a cut is necessary, it will be done in the following order:
 - a. By order of sign up.
 - b. Consideration for those cut from previous lists.
- **3.** The invitationals will count towards tournaments played if played on an assigned golf day.

ARTICLE 10: NOMINATING COMMITTEE

The president will appoint a Nominating Committee for the purpose of submitting a slate of officers to be posted no later than the 1st of November. Ballots will be distributed, collected and counted by this committee. The new officers shall be elected and installed at the awards luncheon/dinner meeting.

ARTICLE 11: SPECIAL AWARDS:

- A. To be eligible for awards at the end of the year, a member must play in at least 50 % of the weekly tournaments.
- **B.** Awards will be given for Low Gross, Low Net, Low putts, Low Ringer Board and the most improved handicap.
- C. Chip-ins, Birdies, Eagles awards may be given to all regardless of times played during the year.

ARTICLE 12: AMENDMENTS

A. The By-Laws of The Tradition Ladies Golf Association are established for the purpose of maintaining an efficient and equitable administration for the membership. They also serve as the basis for understanding the general duties of each officer and chairman and for establishing ease and continuity when newly elected members assume various offices.

B. The **By-Laws** may be appended, repealed or supplemented by **The Executive Board** after approval of a majority vote of the membership at a meeting held in accordance with the provisions contained herein.
