APPROVAL OF MINUTES

On a motion by Debbie Massie, seconded by Rebecca Stacy, it was unanimously voted to approve the League Meeting Minutes of June 2, 2007 as printed.

TREASURER'S REPORT

As of November 8, 2007, the balance in the Tradition Ladies Golf Association Account is \$835.61. Joan Sheldon explained that the majority of this money will go to end-of-year expenses. (Copy of Treasurer's Report is attached)

TOURNAMENT CHAIRMAN REPORT

Daune Barksdale said that it was a very successful year for tournaments and thanked all the people who helped with the tournaments.

REPORT FROM FIRST VICE-PRESIDENT ON 2007 WEEKLY GAMES

- 1. Weekly Game Cancellations Celise McLaughlin asked that if a person who signed up to play on Thursday must cancel, they should do so as early as possible. She explained that it is difficult to reconfigure the players, especially when short notice is given.
- 2. Picking Up Ball Celise McLaughlin wanted everyone to be aware that if they pick up their ball without completing the hole, they must put an X next to the score for that hole. She explained that if the X is not put on the card, if affects the calculating of end-of-year awards.

NEW BUSINESS

- 1. Increase League Dues for 2008 to \$30.00 Joan Sheldon explained that there was a joint meeting of the present and incoming Boards to discuss an increase in the 2008 dues for the League. She had given out copies of proposed budgets showing the annual dues at \$25.00 and \$30.00(copy attached). Joan explained that both Boards feel there is a need for the increase. She then reviewed the proposal, stating that she based the 2008 budgets on 56 members, not the present 60 members, and she did not include any variables such as income from a TLGA dinner and Memorial Day Mulligans. On a motion by Joanne Stewart, seconded by Maureen Lampert, it was unanimously voted to increase the Tradition Ladies Golf Association Dues for 2008 from \$25.00 to \$30.00.
- 2. Review of USGA Procedures for determining "Most Likely Score" and "Averaging Your Score" Joan Sheldon said that if the group is not able to complete 18 holes on League Day, you add the strokes you get on each hole to par and that is your score on the hole. She said that another issue has come up recently regarding if a player wishes to pick up the ball because she is out of the hole (assuming the game being played allows for this). She has two options as follows:
 - A. If the player is not on the green: Post your maximum.
 - B. If the Player is ON THE GREEN: If within the length of a standard putter, add one (1) stroke. Otherwise, add two
 - (2) strokes or putt out.

Celise McLaughlin said in previous years, scores were not posted if the ball was picked up by a player. LGA Rules state that all League scores must be posted, and this causes difficulty when she is trying to calculate who will

> get awards. She suggested that on Thursdays, the players should only pick up when they have reached their maximum, stating that she had no problem with Option 1, but did not agree with Option 2. Joan Sheldon said that she prefers a person picking up if they are out of the whole, and USGA gives a person a way to determine a most likely score. This also helps with play time. Maureen Lampert said that at times she has had an issue with the score a person has given her for a hole. Grace Davis suggested that instead of making it a local rule now that people are aware of the situation, the issue be revisited at the first meeting next year. Lori Doherty felt that people should putt out, but Maureen Lampert felt that if everyone putts out every hole, at this time of year, the League will not finish play. On a motion by Barbara Nuding, seconded by Veronica Bucello, and a vote of 17 in favor and 14 opposed, the following change was made to the Local Rule for TLGA:

> If a player chooses to pick up because she is out of a hole (assuming the game being played allows for this), the options that player has for determining her "most likely score" for that hole are as follows:

Option 1: Player is NOT ON THE GREEN: post your maximum. Option 2: Player if ON THE GREEN: If within the length of a standard putter, add one (1) stroke. Otherwise, add two (2) strokes or putt out.

LOCAL RULE FOR DETERMINING "MOST LIKELY SCORE"

If a player chooses to pick up because she is out of a hole (assuming the game being played allows for this), the options that player has for determining her "most likely score" for that hole are as follows.

OPTION 1. Player is NOT ON THE GREEN: post your maximum.

OPTION 2. Player is ON THE GREEN: If within the length of a standard putter, add one (1) stroke. Otherwise, add two (2) strokes or putt out.
