#### BOARD OF DIRECTORS MEETING

#### MINUTES

### July 28, 2022

- c. Planted 2 bushes at pump station
- d. Holding off on rust stain removal per Board and they are looking into another alternative.
- e. Took old chairs to recycle
- f. BFPE conducted their inspection
- g. Installation of handicap chair tabled for the time being.

### VIII. <u>NEW BUSINESS</u>

- **a.** Goodwins Pool Service will be power washing the pool furniture.
- **b.** Furniture replacement is tabled until 2023
- **c.** New caution sign is up alerting drivers of a blind driveway.
- d. Sidewalk/curb project looks great!
- e. There were five beaver dams to removed.
- **f.** Estimate to remove rust if \$3500.

### Mr. Mclaughlin made a motion, Mr. Moeller seconded, all in favor, it was so moved: The work is approved to completed as per the estimate provided to remove rust.

- g. Trash pick-up service for 2023
  - **a.** Board discussion regarding 2023 Trash registration procedure. Letter will be going out to all homeowners.
  - **b.** Board discussion regarding BFS request for small increase due to rising costs. If prices return to the 2022 levels the increase would be reviewed for a potential return to the original price.

Mr. Philips made a motion, Mr. Baughman seconded it, all in favor, it was moved that: Effective January 1, 2023, there will be a \$1.00 increase per homeowner per month (\$12.00 additional per year) for both trash and recycling services.
